

# COP16 Policy Scorecard

## Implement

### Put the GBF into Action

- Submit ambitious targets that are aligned with the GBF; show progress on updated NBSAPs across all sectors of government.
- Adopt an updated indicator framework that includes disaggregated metrics for inland waters, and sector-specific indicators for mainstreaming.
- Agree on a streamlined DSI financial mechanism for benefit sharing that focuses on the implementation of GBF-aligned targets, and that dedicates funding for IPLCs.



## Integrate

### Mainstream Biodiversity

- Commit to a robust mainstreaming strategy and work plan to support all mainstreaming components of GBF.
- Raise the level of ambition to work towards nature-positive sectoral transitions and make commitments to greening economies.
- Recognize the role of the private sector in protecting nature and maintain robust outcomes for key targets within the GBF.

## Invest

### Expand Nature Finance

- Develop roadmaps for achieving the \$20 billion commitment by 2025, and for increasing financing made directly available to Indigenous Peoples and local communities.
- Leverage existing innovative and inclusive solutions to accelerate, simplify and streamline access to financial resources for nature, equitably.
- Integrate climate and biodiversity finance, recognizing that nature-based solutions are fundamental to delivering on the mitigation and adaptation actions needed to meet the Paris Agreement goals.
