PRIORITY: PUTTING CCA INVESTMENTS TO WORK FOR DECARBONIZATION, RESILIENCE, AND JUSTICE

The 2024 supplemental budget is a unique opportunity to invest revenue from the capand-invest auctions into building the climate future we envision, including:

- Natural Climate Solutions investments for conservation, restoration, and improved management practices in forests, wetlands, and grasslands
- A Just Transition by reducing the financial burden of energy use and investing in workforce development needed for a climate-friendly future
- Recommendations of the **Environmental Justice Council**
- Investments that attract **federal climate funding** for Washington communities

PRIORITY: HOLDING OIL COMPANIES ACCOUNTABLE

Washington currently has no tools that provide transparency into how gas prices are set, or allow the state to interrupt potential unfair pricing practices harming consumers. As oil companies mark record profits, understanding what goes into the price at the pump is an important consumer protection tool. Transparency can also help to daylight any false narratives that aim to halt climate progress for our state.

HB 2232/SB 6052 will require oil companies to report pricing data, sets up a watchdog team within the Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) and creates protections against corporate "greenwashing," when companies make false claims about their climate commitments.

We continue to advocate for legacy funding efforts in the 2024 supplemental budgets, including: DNR Forest Health & Wildfire Resilience (HB 1168), WSDOT Stormwater Retrofits (Move Ahead WA), RCO Washington Coastal Restoration & Resiliency Initiative, and the RCO Community Forests Grant Program.

THE NATURE CONSERVANCY'S NEW STRATEGIC PLAN was developed with our place in the larger environmental movement in mind. Our legacy of credibility and access to resources and decision-makers provides an opportunity to promote equitable policies that support local communities and promote nature-based climate solutions.

Our staff developed three cross-cutting priorities for our new Strategic Plan: 1. Foster right relations with Tribal and First Nations, 2. Center racial equity and environmental justice, and 3. Leverage learning and innovation. These goals serve as the lens through which we approach our work.
